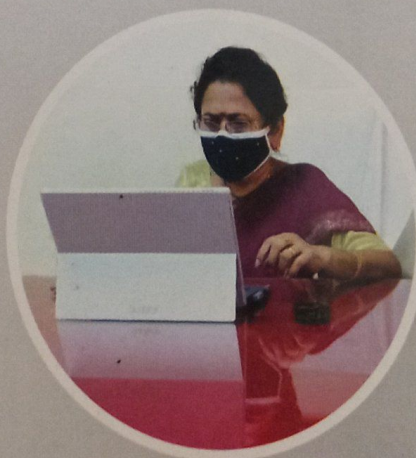
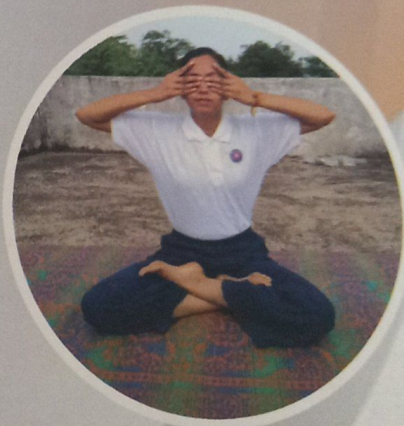

Vision

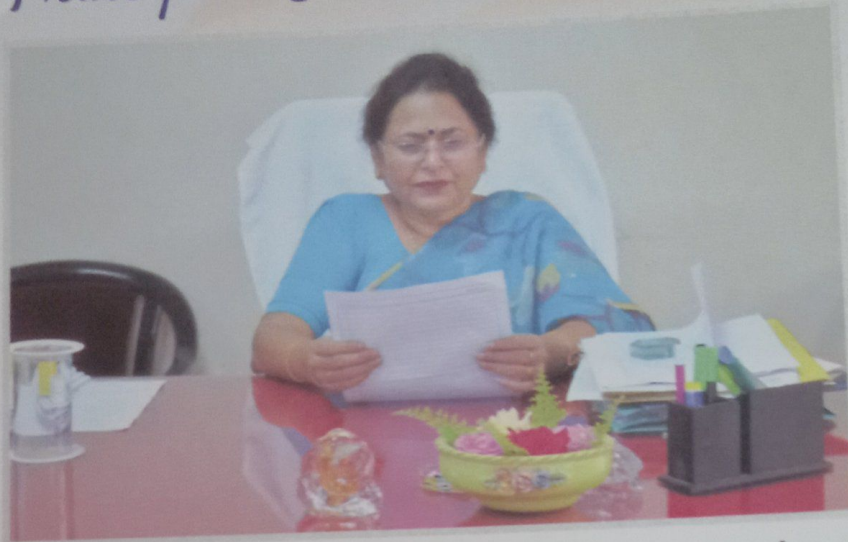

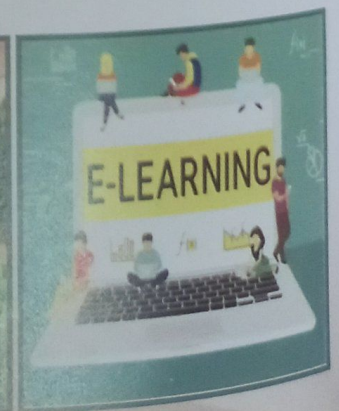

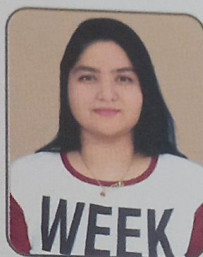

4. Ku. Priti Sahu of M.Sc. Physics qualified the C.G. State Eligibility Test (SET) held in September 2017.



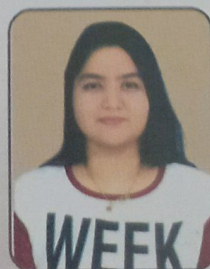
Scaling Greatest Heights!

Dr. Pratiksha Pandey was again invited as a speaker in a National Seminar organised by Govt. Bhim Rao Ambedkar College, Dongargaon.

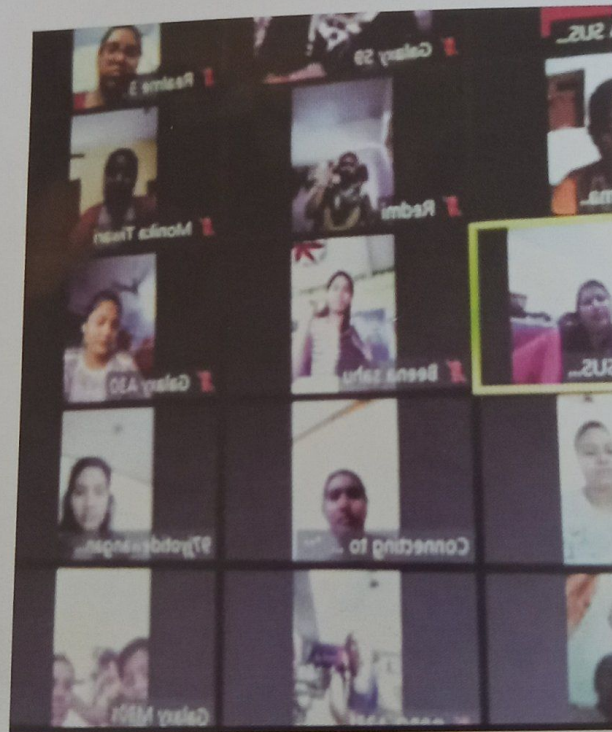
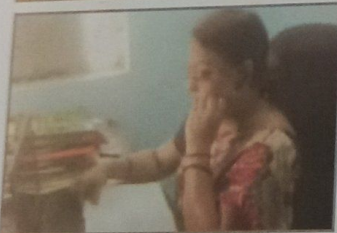
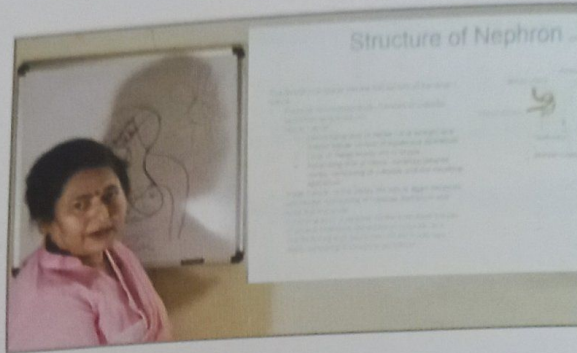
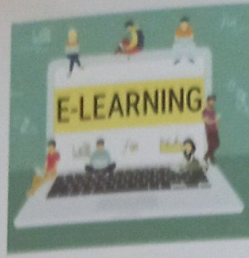

Expanding the Learning Curve through -

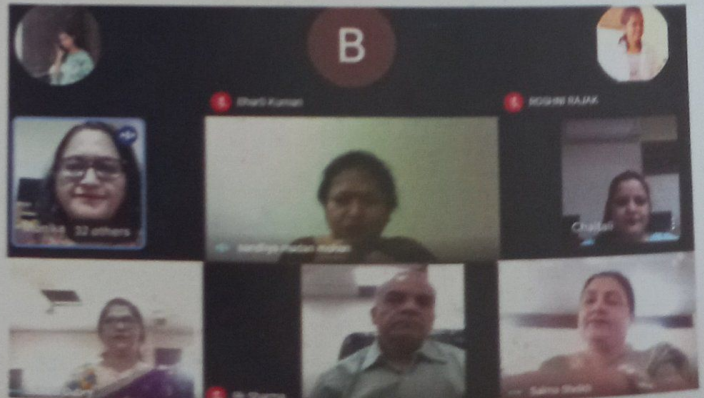
The 1st ever International webinar was organised by the institution on 01.06.2020 on the onset of the new session.

The learned speakers shared their insights on topics relevant to their professions connected with the Pandemic COVID-19.

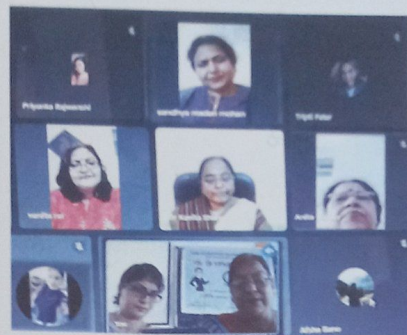

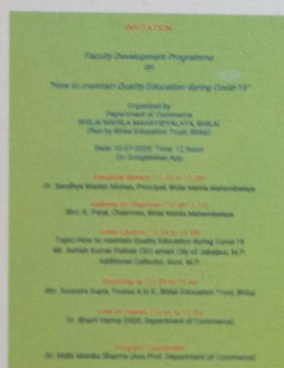
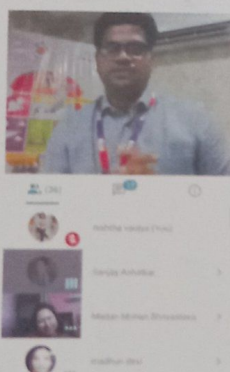
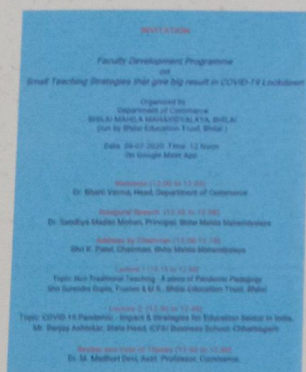


Webinars and online lectures

Service before Self

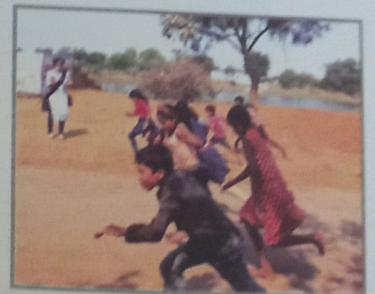
Following the Corona protocol a one day N.S.S. Camp was organised at village Pisseygaon of Durg District on 13.02.2021.


