GUARD YOUR TONE!

Tone is applicable for both modes of communications 'written' as well as 'spoken'. Writing skill, and tone of voice are very powerful means to help our stakeholders respond with positivity. So, guard your tone!

BUILD A RECOGNITION CULTURE!

Count the number of times you say 'Thank You' (well, from the bottom of your heart!) everyday. Count the number of times you have caught someone doing things right today. Count the number of times you have praised people during the day today!

Make every simple form of recognition contagious – like wearing a smile, friendly handshake, a warm hug to your son, daughter, spouse, friend, whoever

Do this and others will follow.

This is how we can build a recognition culture!

BE IMPERSONAL!

The other day we talked about the 'Hot Stove Rule'. It teaches us about another important lesson. It is impersonal. When you touch a hot stove, it burns your fingers. When I touch it, it burns my fingers; when a strongman touches it, his fingers get burnt; when a weak person touches it, he too is not spared. So, it treats everyone the same way. Personal favoritism has to be avoided in running of an institution.

Be Impersonal

BE CONSISTENT!

Consistency in our approach is important. This is one of the principles of the 'Hot Stove Rule'. When you touch a hot stove, it burns your fingers. And it does burn your fingers every time you do it. So, it is consistent. We must be consistent in our behaviour.

One parent praises or reprimands for a behaviour and the other ignores, or worst still, does the opposite; one teacher praises the student for a behaviour and another says, "What is great about it?" What will the child or the student do? Children crave for consistency. They crave for the stability, reliability and dependability that comes with consistency. It creates trust. It promotes positive behaviour.

Be consistent, not only as an individual but institution wide

DECLARE YOUR INTENTION PUBLICLY!

It is always better to pronounce your intention to achieve something. When you announce that you wish to aim at achieving something great, there is a pressure on you, an external pressure, to work hard and realise the goal

Fear not, shy not out, be bold and announce, howsoever difficult the target might be!

Go ahead, Declare your intention publicly!

SAY-DO-GAP!

What we do and what we say are closely linked. Let us imagine a situation where there is a gap between what we say and what we do! We say someone not to indulge in smoking but, we ourselves smoke! What happens! No one will heed to what we say. People will follow what we do. This is true for all situations. To close the say-do-gap is extremely necessary for leaders, parents, teachers

So, do not have a gap in what you say and what you do!

HAVE A DEADLINE!

Deadlines force us to work in such a way that we aim at completing the assignment in time. Weinvariably meet the deadline! Imagine a situation, where there is no target date. What happens in such an event? We work at will. Sometimes, such assignments never get completed! Open-ended activities having no time frame for their completion, take a back seat.

With deadlines, we are focused. We are disciplined. We work to achieve the goal. It creates a sense of urgency in us. When we meet the deadline, it gives us a sense of fulfilment!

So, have a deadline!

FEAR MAGNIFIED, FEAR GLORIFIED!

Dreams we dream! We wish them come true! But, do you know, it is the fear, yes, fear of failure that has killed many of our dreams before they had a chance of being launched! Fear breeds in us reasons for our inability to do something we are, in fact, capable of! Fear of failure robs us of our chance of success! We magnify our fears more than we do our abilities – just remember, you are more capable than you think you are!

So, shun fear. Do not magnify fear ... do not glorify fear! Give yourself a try! Your dream, every dream will come true! Yes, you have the capability!.....

EXCUSES, EXCUSES AND MORE EXCUSES!

We are quite creative when it comes to making excuses! We can often find excuses more easily rather than reasons why we need to do something. They can range from not having enough time to the stars not being correctly aligned. Many-a-times, we fail because someone else did not do his/ her part of the job. Invariably, it is 'the other person' to be blamed. Or is it fear, anxiety, uncertainty of mind or just plain laziness? Sometimes, it feels easier and safer not to do anything at all than tackling what needs to be taken care of. Whatever the case, they (the excuses) paralyse us.

Excuses, excuses and more excuses and more and more excuses! These will kill us. Arise! give them up!

REMEMBER, EVERY ACT OF OURS SENDS A MESSAGE!

Ishikawa propagated Ishikawa Diagram. It is also known as Fishbone Diagram or Cause and Effect Diagram. Every effect has one or more causes or every cause leads to an effect. What we do, therefore, sends a message. More important is what we do rather than what we say. Even a child observes what we do. No matter what we preach, he is influenced by our deeds. Just remember, everything that you do, or for that matter, something that you are supposed to do and you do not do, sends messages to the environment you are surrounded with. Just do what is just. The effect will be positive and pleasant.

Let us remember, every act or omission of ours sends a message!

MAKE MISTAKES, MAKE MORE MISTAKES!

Yes, make mistakes, make more mistakes and yet again, make mistakes and make more mistakes! It does not end at that. Celebrate mistakes, learn to appreciate the individual who makes mistakes, reward one who makes a mistake! Yes, it is not easy, but, that is the key to progress. Thomas Edison made 10,000 mistakes to invent the light bulb and make his dream of converting night into day come true!

But, just remember, it must be a new mistake each time!

Let us make mistakes and make more and more mistakes!

LET US BE BETTER THAN THE BEST!

I have a dream: To Be Better Than The Best! Make it your dream! Let us aim to be better than the best in the field we are in!

Having aimed to be better than the best, we have to achieve it. And to achieve it one mantra is to give the most of you to it. Well, more than the most. Have you observed one phenomenon?
