7.1.7 – The Institution has disabled-friendly, barrier free environment

1. Built environment with ramps/lifts for easy access to classrooms. outside chemistry lab

2. Disabled- friendly Washrooms. (picture of commode)

3. Signage including tactile path, lights, display boards and signposts

4. Assistive technology and facilities for persons with disabilities (Divyangjan) accessible website, screen-reading software, mechanized equipment

5. Provision for enquiry and information: Human assistance, reader, scribe, soft copies of reading material, screen reading.

Differently abled

1. The college provides admission and special guidance and counselling to differently abled students. Special care and help is extended to them as per their needs and requirement. Wheel chair is provided to those who are unable to walk so that they can conveniently be moved in through tactile paths with ramps at the entrance and railings along the staircase. Friends and attendants are always ready to help whenever need be. Special Assistance is extended to them by their friends and attendants. It is kept in mind that the classrooms of the especially abled are conducted at the ground floor with special seating arrangements in the class and labs as well. The Divyanjan students of the college are encouraged and motivated like any other student of the class without making them feel that they are suffering from any kind of disability. They are given the chance and opportunity to participate in all kinds of activities to the best possible extent which is within their ability and their participation and performance has always been praiseworthy. Built ramps/ for easy access to classroom Ramps are built at entry and other points of the building, so that the wheel chairs can be easily pushed in through them. It is kept in mind that classes of disabled students are conducted on the ground floor and there special seating arrangement is provided to such students in the labs as well. Classmates of such students are ever ready to assist and help them whenever need be.

- 2. There are limited number of disabled students as such there is no separate disabled friendly washroom but these students are allowed to use the washroom with western commodes meant for staff members.
- 3. Special Lights display boards and signboards indicating direction and locations of rooms etc can be seen all around the building.
- 4. Human assistance in the form of writers and readers during exams are provided to those with weak eyesight and even to those who have met with fractures. on applications even to those who have met with fractures.
