The level of attainment of Program Outcomes, Program Specific Outcomes and Course Outcomes are measured using various indicators throughout the semester of the academic year.

The faculty records the performance of each student with the help of the specified course outcomes through a continuous evaluation process. The faculty provides home assignments to students, conducts weekly monthly internal tests, viva voce, surprise tests, open book tests, quiz, projects seminar's presentations etc. in order to assess the Programme Outcomes and Programme Specific outcomes attained by each student.

Some of the key indicators of measuring attainment are:

- 1. Internal Assessment: The Internal Assessment constitutes 10% in UG and 20% in PG weightage of the total marks (100) in each subject. The students are given assignments are conducted repeatedly in a semester to judge the performance of students on a regular basis.
- 2. Practical Assessment/ External Assessment: It is evaluated by inviting external experts appointed by the university to evaluate each student by conducting Practical examinations, and taking Viva-Voce and evaluating the practical files. In PG 20% of the practical marks are sent to the University as internal assessment.
- 3. End Semester University Examination: Being affiliated by Hemchand Yadav University, the students of Bhilai Mahila Mahavidyalaya are required to take examinations as per the semester and annual pattern set by the university, through which the institution measures programme outcomes based on the course attainment level fixed by the programme.
- 4. Result Analysis: At the end of each semester/ Annual Exam, result analysis of each course is carried out in percent, bar cart and bar diagram indicating the percentage of students falling in different categories of CGPA obtained. This is an effective indicator in order to evaluate the level of attainment of POS, PSOS and COS as specified by the university.
- 5. Internships and Placements: Students are encouraged to take up internships, projects, fieldwork, etc. The Placement Cell of the college helps and polishes the students according to industry standards and provides ample opportunities for students to get placed in esteemed companies. This helps them to obtain necessary skills practical experience Experiential learning in their chosen discipline.
